Re: Manufacturer's Certification, MIL-PRF-19500P, FSC 5961; VQ (VQE-14-027151); CAGE Code: 21845; Ctrl # 040773.

Your facility at 3301 Electronics Way, West Palm Beach, FL, was audited by Mr. Zade Karadsheh and Mr. Brad Deslich of this Center and Mr. Benny Damron representing NASA during November 6 - 8, 2012 for compliance with the Manufacturer's Certification requirements of MIL-PRF-19500P. All deficiencies found during the audit are now closed.

Compliance with these requirements has been successfully demonstrated; therefore Solitron Devices Inc. is considered a certified manufacturer eligible to qualify and supply JAN, JANTX, and JANTXV low and high power transistor and J-FET semiconductor devices in accordance with the requirements of MIL-PRF-19500P. Your certified assembly packages are the TO-3, TO-5, TO-18, TO-39, TO-59, TO-63, TO-66, TO-71, TO-72 and TO-114.

Wafer fabrication and assembly is to be performed at the 3301 Electronics Way facility. All qualification tests, conformance inspections, and screening must be performed at facilities that have DLA Land and Maritime-VQE Laboratory Suitability Status for each of the applicable test methods.

This certification will normally be valid for two years from the date of this letter and can only be terminated by written notification from this Center. For the duration of the certification, the manufacturer is subject to periodic reviews by the qualifying activity or its representatives. Certification will not normally be extended beyond the two-year period without a re-audit.

Note: The results of the DLA Land and Maritime-VQE audit held during November 6 - 8, 2012 were found by examining a sampling of the manufacturer's normal manufacturing, and processing procedures. The acceptance of the corrective actions from the above referenced audit does not relieve the manufacturer of its contractual obligation to deliver product that complies with all specification requirements. Manufacturers are required to inform this office immediately after learning of a potential issuance of a GIDEP alert, problem advisory, or other notification on their QML product.
